CRCHC Establishes Homeless Clinic with Rowan Helping Ministries, Inc.

Concord, NC – Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Centers, Inc. (CRCHC), announces a partnership with Rowan Helping Ministries (RHM), to establish a health clinic at Rowan Helping Ministries for the homeless and underserved population.

The partnership between CRCHC and Rowan Helping Ministries will provide an on-site clinic on a weekly basis at Rowan Helping Ministries' Crisis Assistance building at 226 North Long Street Salisbury, NC and the Rowan Helping Ministries shelter at 217 North Long Street Salisbury, NC. Primary medical care, behavioral health services, patient health education, and transportation services to CRCHC's other clinics will be offered.

"I am appreciative of our staff's dedication and diligence. We are privileged to be able to offer services on site to individuals that were previously going without care or relying on emergency rooms for access to health care." said Robert Freeman, Chairman of CRCHC Board of Directors.

"CRCHC recognizes that homelessness and health are co-factors of a person's well-being. Through this partnership we aim to improve the overall well-being of indigent individuals through primary care and behavioral health services offered on site. We are excited about the partnership with RHM and our ability to reduce some of the many barriers this population faces" said Don Holloman, Chief Executive Officer at CRCHC.

Rowan Helping Ministries is a continuation of Rowan Cooperative Christian Ministry, a ministry begun in 1967 by several of Salisbury's downtown churches. Rowan Helping Ministries was incorporated as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization September 18, 1986. In December 1989, all programs moved to 226 North Long Street and became a part of Rowan Helping Ministries. Our programs include: The Shelter, Jeannie's Kitchen, Clothing Center, Food Pantry, Crisis Assistance Network, Transitional Housing Programs, Rowan Helping Ministries-West, New Tomorrows, and Food for Thought.
